


The TCEEL Experience

Program Details

The Teleos Coaching Essentials Program for Education Leaders (TCEEL) brings together education leaders from across the country, and from across all levels of school, network, and district leadership. This diverse group is united by their desire to use coaching in their leadership to build more resonant relationships and nurture the growth necessary to build collaborative and high-functioning teams. These leaders support staff to be their most powerful selves, with the focus of their work centered on student well-being, wholeness, and achievement.

This 5-month program includes two in-person workshops at Teleos Leadership Institute, located just outside Philadelphia. In between workshop dates, you'll work with faculty to implement and practice what you're learning through group mentoring and one-on-one check-ins. The faculty for this course include coaches who have worked as education leaders and have experience working with leaders in a coaching capacity at all levels of education.

I'd like to use more coaching in my leadership but I don't want to be a full time coach. Is this program still for me?

Yes! This program is for education leaders who want to use coaching techniques to support their teams. Specifically, this program is for you if you want to improve your ability to build strong relationships and use observation, inquiry, and personal presence to build collaborative teams and support people as they grow and change.

After I complete this program, will I be certified?

This program provides you with everything you need to apply for ACC level certification with the ICF. ACC-level certification requires at least 60 hours of coach training as well as 100 hours of coaching practice. The coaching you do alongside this program can count towards your 100 hours.

I work in a district office, as a charter school principal; in the central office of a large CMO; as a public school principal; as a superintendent - is this program for me?

Yes! The skills you'll learn are applicable to school buildings, across school networks, and with teams supporting schools. In addition, the community you'll build through this program will help expand your perspective and strengthen your networks.


